

## Minutes of Seton Assembly Meeting

February 12, 2024

The Faithful Navigator called the meeting to order at 6:30 PM. Prayer was offered and the Pledge was recited.

The minutes of the prior meeting were approved.

Navigator reported that forms are being provided for any activities in which a member participated. The member is asked to fill in the form and submit it to Sir Wilcox.
